Beaver Creek School Advisory Council has discussed the various options for calendars. Several issues have surfaced that bring the opportunity to discuss calendars:

- Families with different calendars for elementary students and high school students at Mingus or Camp Verde struggle to balance family time
- One Hour Professional Development early release on Wednesdays does not give staff enough time to work on planning and curriculum creating teacher burn out.
- Office staff that also serves as district staff need more time for district work without interruptions.
- The district now has the 21st Century Grant allowing for Friday Programming for Students.
- Families and staff are far from banking, shopping, and medical appointments. Fridays could serve as a day to help with family chores and errands.

The Advisory Council plans to have families and staff surveyed on the options and bring the recommendation to the Governing Board on March 2. Two of the options include a 4 day week with the 21st Century program offering enrichment activities to students on Fridays.
