DO NOT use conversion factors

If family reports income sources from more than one schedule Example: alimony = \$100 / month & pension = \$300 / week

Yearly Income = Monthly x 12

Yearly Income = Twice Per Month (Bi-Monthly) x 24

Yearly Income = Every Two Weeks (Bi-Weekly) x 26

Yearly Income = Week x 52

DO NOT round the values resulting from each conversion
