    The current leases are up in May. Operations Manager Karen Dufresne has received the bids for the leases and recommends the SHARP copiers.

This increase will help to offset the increase cost for employees and will be an increase of \$29,640.00 for FY24 for all district paid benefits (Health, Life, Vision, Dental). There was no increase to Vision or Dental and there was a decrease in Life Insurance.
