- B. Specific Items of District Business which require Action
 - a. Request for discussion and request for annual approval of the contract with Rise Resource Center. This request was tabled at the August 14, 2023 meeting. RISE is providing special education for placement of students whose disability and behaviors warrant private placement as decided by the school team and parents.
 - b. Request for discussion and approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Yavapai County for a 10 month School Resource Officer paid through the safety grant with the Arizona Department of Education. This IGA was crafted by the district attorney and used in other Yavapai County Schools.
 - c. Request for discussion and approval of the 5th grade Field Trip to the Arizona Science Center in Phoenix on 11/16/23.
 - d. Request for discussion and possible approval for an expenditure for the soccer/football field plan for addressing safety and maintenance. The School Facilities Board was noticed of inadequacy. The TRUST reviewed the field for safety issues. The field is very uneven with different densities of grass, gopher holes, and elevation changes. The district has received 2 quotes and these will be discussed at the board meeting with a recommendation for approval and funding plan presented.
 - e. Request for discussion and ratification of purchases of the 10 iPads and 2 year AppleCare+ for Schools for \$11,101.34. The order was made not realizing that the AppleCare would put the expenditure for the preschool iPads over the \$10,000 threshold. Most of this expenditure is paid out of a DES preschool grant and needed to be expended by September 30, 2023.
